ACSI has been closely monitoring the continuing developments over the implementation of tariffs on imported raw materials and finished goods into the United States. ACSI has already started to incur tariffs from multiple sources. I know most of you have received letters from some door and hardware manufacturers outlining their tariff plans. The tariffs continue to be a moving target.

Effective May 1, 2025, any orders placed on or after that date, the following list price added adjustments will be implemented to ACSI Price Book #10:
